

## Winner of the 2008 IAG Early Career Researcher Award

### Alon Amrani

The winner of our 2008 IAG Early Career Researcher Award was Dr Alon Amrani, then at the California Institute of Technology, for his paper entitled *Development of coupled GC/ICPMS for the analysis of  $\delta^{34}\text{S}$  in individual organic compounds*. This was selected from 517 potential candidates. The Award was presented at the Goldschmidt conference in Vancouver.

Dr Amrani is now Associate Professor in the Institute of Earth Sciences at the Hebrew University of Jerusalem. His interests include organic geochemistry and biogeochemistry, petrochemistry, stable isotopes and the sulphur cycle.
